

Mobility within the EU applying to third-country nationals

Regulations on mobility within the EU applying to students of non-EU nationality (third-country nationals) coming to the EU for the purpose of studying

If you wish to study at TH Rosenheim as exchange student and have already been issued a residence permit for studies in another EU member state, you can come to study without having to apply for a visa for Germany. In this case, you have to submit additional documents to the International Office at TH Rosenheim. We can then apply for a confirmation for your stay here.

Mobility within the EU is facilitated under the following conditions

- Studies in an EU member state with a residence permit of this EU member state for the purpose of studies
- Student has been accepted at TH Rosenheim under an exchange programme (ERASMUS, bilateral exchange programme) from a Partner University
- A residence permit of an EU member state that is valid for the duration of studies at TH Rosenheim (if necessary, have the residence permit extended in due time before the mobility!)
- Submission of the additional documents to TH Rosenheim at least 60 days prior to entering Germany.

Note:

If the documents submitted are incomplete or the conditions are not fulfilled, you are not permitted to study at TH Rosenheim.
