<u>Learning objectives:</u> <u>Content:</u>	Armed with the basics of Mandarin Chinese written and oral lan- guage structure, students will be able to introduce themselves, have a basic conversation about family, food, transportation, weather, time, location, hobbies; go shopping, sightseeing and get help in an emergency; write in pinyin. They will understand the so- cio-economic-political roots of Chinese culture and the differences between Chinese and Western (German/American) cultures so that they can comport themselves respectfully in China. A variety of teaching and fun learning methods will be used to learn
	Mandarin Chinese phonetics and pronunciation, pinyin phonetic transcription, basic characters, sentence structure and grammar. Everyday phrases will be taught in the context of modern daily life in China, a sightseeing day in a Chinese city and in the countryside, a business introduction and meal at a restaurant. Cultural and Be- havioral Differences between Chinese, Taiwanese and global Dias- pora will be reviewed from individual cultural contexts.
