LOCATION The HEPL has a building comprised of 31 rooms (including one equipped for a Person with Reduced Mobility) to accommodate Erasmus students.



	You will reside in Jemeppe (Seraing), just next to Campus 2000 (where the trainings of the economic, educational and social faculties take place): - 200 m from bus and train stations, - 300 m from food stores, - 10 km from the center of Liège and 100 km from Brussels. Note: The International Relations Office is on the ground floor of the building. 4. EQUIPMENT On 2 floors, the rooms (11 m²) consist of basic furniture (bed, desk, wardrobes), a shower, a sink and a toilet. Each room has an internet connection. 5. COMMUNAL AREAS A whole floor includes an equipped shared kitchen, a dining room, a large room for relaxation and study, terraces (including a vegetated one). In addition, this floor has WIFI. In the basement, a laundry room (automatic machine, electric dryer, ironing board and iron) is available to students. 6. ROOMS - Single room - Single room with shared bathroom 7.
