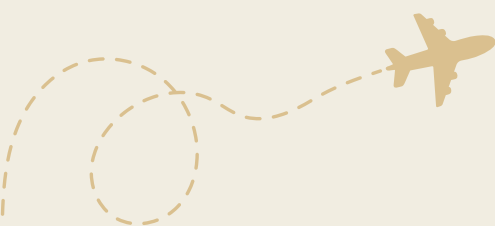

Academic Calendar	The academic year at UFSC is divided into two semesters. The first semester usually starts in March and ends in July, while the second semester generally starts in August and ends in December. Undergraduate Grading System	<p>Academic performance is assessed by the student's attendance and grades in each course.</p> <p>Grades are expressed in values ranging from 0.0 (zero) to 10.0 (ten). In order to pass a course, students must obtain a final average grade equal to or greater than 6.0 (six) and minimum attendance of 75%. Credit system/class hours	<p>At UFSC, the evaluation is not based on CREDITS, it is based on HOURS per course; 1 credit may be equivalent to either 18 or 15 hours (it will depend on each course).</p>

Housing	UFSC does not offer housing for exchange students. Thus, students must search for their own accommodation.
