# THE MOBILITY PROCESS

## 1 NOMINATION

**Universities** can nominate their students completing the **OFFICIAL NOMINATION FORM** within the nomination period. Any inquiries, send an e-mail to: [incoming-exchange@salleurl.edu](mailto:incoming-exchange@salleurl.edu)  
Nominating students does not grant their automatic acceptance.

## 2 APPLICATION

All nominated **students** will receive an application form where they must submit:  
**a)**Photo **b)**Passport **c)**Transcript of grades **d)**Language Proficiency **e)**Motivation letter  
\*Animation and Digital arts students must also submit a portfolio.

## 3 RESOLUTION

After applications are evaluated, students will receive a resolution. If it is positive, the e-mail will contain an **acceptance and visa letter** (if needed).  
Applicants should **not** book accommodation or plain tickets before being officially accepted.

## 4 SELECTING COURSES

Accepted students will be assigned an academic coordinator who will send them the list of available courses, the respective schedules, and the guidelines to select their courses.  
Only after this process is done, academic coordinators will sign their Learning Agreements.

## 5 CERTIFICATES OF ARRIVAL - DEPARTURE

All students who need the signing of a certificate of arrival/departure, must request the signature **in person at the global students office**. Students must bring **their home university's form**.  
This certificate can only be signed by the incoming coordinator.

## 6 CHANGES IN ENROLLMENT

During the first two weeks of class, students will be able to add or drop classes that were selected in the first place, this changes must be accepted by their academic coordinators.

## 7 TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS

After the retakes are evaluated, [incoming-exchange@salleurl.edu](mailto:incoming-exchange@salleurl.edu) will send student and the corresponding coordinator of the Home University their transcript of records.
