APPLICATION FORM AND VISA INFORMATION FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS

Students must apply for the mobility at the home university and once approved, should complete the ‘*UniKL Inbound Application Form*’ available at <https://www.unikl.edu.my/admission/exchange-mobility/areas/>

Required documents:

Students must submit the form, along with the following documents:

8. Medical Screening

PRE – ARRIVAL:

- Mobility students who are citizens of the 14 countries that are listed below are exempted from pre-arrival medical screening: the countries are **United Kingdom, Japan, USA, Australia, South Korea, Belgium, Finland, France, Germany, Netherlands, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland,** and Turkey.

Students from the above countries will be required to submit a declaration of their health status.

- Students whose nationalities is **NOT** included in the country listed above need to compulsory attend pre-arrival medical screening at EMGS registered clinics: <https://educationmalaysia.gov.my/get-started/medical-and-health-insurance/registered-overseas-clinics.html>

In the event that there is no EMGS registered clinic available, the student can use the Medical Examination Report, (<https://educationmalaysia.gov.my/media/docs/Health-Examination-Reportv1.7.pdf>) and proceed to attend the medical screening in a non-registered clinic. The Medical Examination Report should be filled out by the examining doctor and the scanned copy should be submitted via email to UniKL (msufiza@unikl.edu.my/all.uio@unikl.edu.my).

!!! The Immigration Office accepts only medical examination done within 90 days before arrival in Malaysia.

POST-ARRIVAL:

- **All students** are required to attend a medical examination once they have arrived in Malaysia in any of the EMGS Panel clinic listed (<https://educationmalaysia.gov.my/how-to-apply/medical-screening/registered-overseas-clinics.html/>) within SEVEN (7) days of arrival. Any students who fail this medical screening will not be issued with a student pass and will be required to leave the country. **This medical test include drug/ cannabis test too: pleased be more attentive to this matter, as drug laws in Malaysia may differ from those in the other countries.**

INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE STUDENTS PROCESSING FEE must to be paid in cash upon arrival: RM 120.00 per student.

Visa Requirements

UIO will facilitate students with any inquiries during the visa application process.

Please be informed that effective 15 December 2016, all students must obtain single entry visa from the Malaysian Embassy of the Home Country prior to entry Malaysia. **DO NOT PURCHASE FLIGHT TICKET BEFORE RECEIVING THE SINGLE ENTRY VISA FROM THE MALAYSIAN EMBASSY/ HIGH COMMISSION AT YOUR HOME COUNTRY.**

In the absence of Malaysian Embassy/ High Commission at your home country (for example: Portugal, you may obtain your Visa on Arrival at the airport in Malaysia upon your arrival).

As soon as you have fulfilled all the visa required documents and submit to us, we will issue you an Acceptance Letter and Visa Application Guidelines. Then you will apply the student visa directly through EMGS online system.

Note: You may be required to re-submit/add documentation depending on EMGS requirement during the visa application process.

Payment: You have to make visa payment directly to EMGS.

Visa processing fee:

- VISA APPLICATION PROCESSING FEE: the amount varies as it depends on the citizenship, on the duration of the mobility and other varying factors;
 - INSURANCE: depends on the package that students chose among those approved by EMGS;
 - MEDICAL SCREENING UPON ARRIVAL IN MALAYSIA: RM 250
 - I-KAD (expatriate identification card): RM 50
- (* Fee for those who need to get the medical screening before the arrival not included.**

Upon approval of the student visa, you may download your E Visa Approval Letter (EVAL).

Student must immediately apply for a single entry pass from the Malaysian Embassy/ Malaysian Representative Office in the home university country.

Upon arrival in Malaysia and after having passed the Medical Screening, UIO will collect passport from the students and submit to EMGS/Immigration to get the endorsement of the student visa.

UIO WELCOMING SERVICE

- Students are advised to notify UniKL International Office (all.uio@unikl.edu.my) at least 10 days before arrival to Malaysia by providing full information (flight number, date and time)
- Airport pickup is offered during working days (except on Malaysian public holidays), subject to the availability of UniKL transportation. Campus transfer is offered to exchange students going to campuses outside of Kuala Lumpur and Selangor, subject to the availability of UniKL transportation. Students are encouraged to arrive the week before the beginning of the semester.

UNIKL DRESS CODE

Students must be appropriately dressed when in lecture halls, administration offices, labs, during practical trainings, library, religious places and any other place within UniKL Campus/ Institute at all times. The dress code at UniKL is long pants with collared shirt/polo shirt for male students and long pants/blouse or knee length skirt/ dress for female students.

LIVING EXPENSES IN KUALA LUMPUR

The average living cost per month is around RM2000 – RM3000 in Kuala Lumpur. This estimation varies depending on location and type of accommodation, food and phone bills and wi-fi and other expenses.

It is generally cheaper in other cities/States outside of Kuala Lumpur.
