III Procedure for registering for compulsory elective subjects, compulsory elective modules, elective subjects and guidelines for the training contract and internship report

Compulsory elective subject and compulsory elective module as a compulsory subject:

By registering for a certificate of achievement from the announced catalogues of subject-specific compulsory elective modules (subject B30) as well as from the catalogues of compulsory elective modules (subject no. B32-B53), the corresponding module is listed as a compulsory module with all examination law consequences. Participants in this compulsory module are listed by name on the corresponding lists of participants and grades.

Subjects as voluntary electives:

If participation in a subject is only to take place in the form of a voluntary elective without effect for the Bachelor's examination, registration must be waived for this and an elective certificate form must be submitted to the examiner to document the grade. Participants in such voluntary elective subjects are <u>not included in</u> the corresponding lists of participants and grades. The corresponding transcripts of records are therefore also not recorded in the Online Service Centre.

An elective subject will therefore only be included in the Bachelor's examination certificate if the graded elective subject certificate is submitted to the Examinations Office at the latest before the last performance record in a compulsory subject required for the Bachelor's examination.

Guidelines for the training contract and internship report:

The forms are available from the Internship Office with the documents for the practical semester or on the website for the practical semester.

Training contract:

Please complete the digital contract carefully:

- In addition to the company name, the area of responsibility and the exact address must also be given in the details of the training centre
- Time from to when the internship will be completed. Please note: The mandatory internship must not exceed 18 weeks (Minimum Wage Act)
- Name of the supervisor and his/her function in the company
- Stamp of the company and signatures

The contract must be submitted to the Internship Office via the TH Rosenheim document management system (<u>DMS</u>). Technical approval is given by the Faculty's Internship Officer.

III.I General

Prerequisites for the award of credit points in module B27 Internship are

- the submission of an internship certificate from the internship company and the complete internship report in due time and in accordance with the university's form. These documents must be sent or handed in by the deadline published by the Internship Office
- the assessment of the internship report by the appointed examiners with "successfully completed"
- the assessment of an oral examination (15 minutes) by the appointed examiners with "successfully completed". The examination dates of the respective semester are announced by the examiners and are binding.

All dates are published in the timetable for the respective semester.

III.II Content and structure of the internship report

- 1. Identification of the training company (e.g. company data, business areas, product range, organisation)
- 2. Description of the individual training contents, organised thematically, e.g. according to tasks, activities, projects, responsibilities, backgrounds, results
- 3. Progress of the training, organised thematically according to acquired knowledge, skills, personal experience, assessments
- 4. Date of completion, signatures of trainee and representative of the training centre

III.III Formal requirements

The report must contain the following forms:

- 1. Cover sheet Overall report
- 2. Affidavit
- 3. Certificate
- 4. Training programme (only to be used for internships in several companies/departments)

The report must be written independently in a clear and concise form and supplemented with graphical representations and annexes. It must be submitted in a neat, printed form in a transparent loose-leaf binder and must also meet the formal standards of an <u>academic paper</u>.

1 text page DIN A4 per internship week, including graphs and tables, font size 11 - 12, line spacing 1.5.
